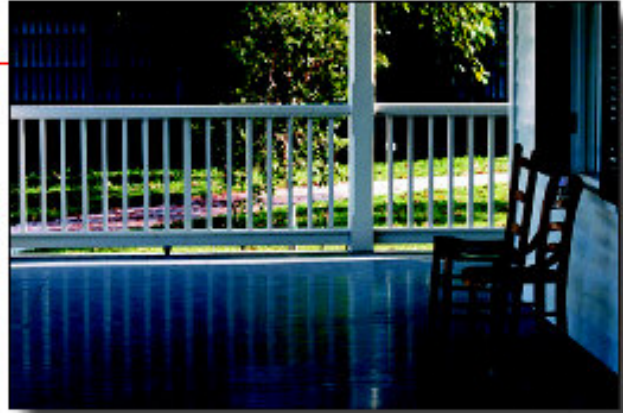


Suffolk, Virginia
